CRITERIA:

- The honoree is an active duty member of the United States Armed Forces or a Veteran
- The applicant must be a current resident of Coachella or immediate family member of a resident of Coachella
- Priority will be based on receipt date of application

HOW TO ORDER:

- Complete the attached order form
- Priority will be given to active military members that reside in the City of Coachella

INCLUDE:

- An official 5x7 military photo of the honoree in his/her military uniform
- Branch of service
- Verification of military service (Refer to the Department of Defense website and submit a copy of the verification page)
- Proof of residency

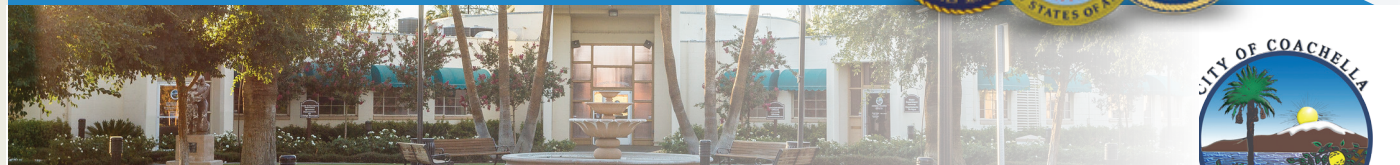

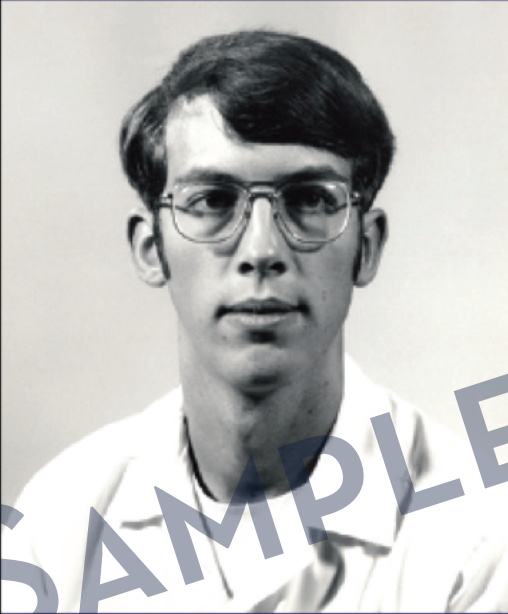
